### Tour 1: Gyeongju UNESCO Heritage Exploration

Gyeongju, a city that carries the legacy of a thousand years. Once the capital of the Silla Kingdom, this historic city preserves a quiet beauty where the past and the present exist in harmony.

This tour takes participants to two of Korea’s most treasured UNESCO sites—Bulguksa Temple and Seokguram Grotto. Nestled along the mountain slopes, Bulguksa Temple is renowned for its graceful architecture and iconic stone pagodas, embodying the spiritual depth and artistic refinement of Silla Buddhist culture.

The journey continues to Seokguram Grotto, located on the hillside of Mount Toham. Here, visitors encounter the serene granite Buddha statue, widely regarded as one of the finest masterpieces of Buddhist sculpture in the world. Within the carefully constructed stone chamber, the remarkable craftsmanship and philosophical ideals of the 8th century are beautifully preserved.

More than a visit to historical sites, this experience is a journey into the aesthetic and spiritual world of the Silla Kingdom. Surrounded by landscapes where architecture, nature, and faith exist in harmony, participants are invited to discover the timeless beauty of Korea’s cultural heritage.

### Tour 2: Timeless Gyeongju: From Silla Heritage to Hwangridan-gil

Gyeongju offers a rare opportunity to experience both the legacy of the Silla Kingdom and the lively charm of modern Korean culture within a single walk. This tour explores the historic heart of the ancient capital while revealing how the city continues to evolve today.

The experience begins at Cheomseongdae, one of the oldest surviving astronomical observatories in East Asia and a remarkable testament to the scientific knowledge of the Silla Kingdom. Nearby, the gentle grassy mounds of the Daereungwon Tomb Complex mark the resting places of Silla royalty, offering a striking glimpse into the power and prestige of Korea’s ancient rulers.

The tour then leads to Hwangridan-gil, a vibrant cultural street where beautifully restored hanok houses now host cafés, galleries, and boutique shops. Blending tradition with contemporary creativity, the area has become one of Gyeongju’s most beloved gathering places.

From royal tombs to lively streets, this journey reveals a different side of Gyeongju—one where history and modern life naturally meet.
